ORDER

The Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals has instructed this Court to determine whether Plaintiff is entitled to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal and, if so, to collect the \$605 appellate filing fee in installments. ([Doc. 33](#).) Plaintiff has recently filed a forty-seven page Notice that includes an IFP Application and Calculation Sheet. ([Doc. 27 at 10-14](#).) Based on that financial information, the Court determines Plaintiff is entitled to proceed *in forma pauperis* and must pay an initial partial filing fee of \$117.44. *See* [28 U.S.C. § 1915\(b\)](#). If Plaintiff's institutional account does not contain the full amount assessed as an initial partial filing fee, Plaintiff's custodian shall withdraw any portion of the initial partial filing fee available, even if the account balance is under \$10. Regardless of the balance in the account, the custodian shall continue to withdraw funds until the initial partial filing fee has been paid in full. After the initial partial filing fee has been collected, the custodian shall collect monthly payments in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the preceding month's income credited to Plaintiff's institutional account, each time the amount exceeds \$10, until the \$350 statutory filing fee is paid in full. *See* [28 U.S.C. § 1915\(b\)\(2\)](#). All payments forwarded on Plaintiff's behalf must be clearly identified by the name and number assigned to this action.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT:

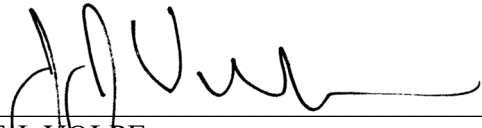
1. Plaintiff is GRANTED permission to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal.

2. The Warden, designee, or future custodian shall collect the \$605 appellate filing fee as directed in this Order.

3. The Clerk shall mail a copy of this Order to the Warden, El Reno Federal Correctional Institution, P.O. Box 1500, El Reno, OK 73036.

4. Plaintiff is directed to file any future documents or pleadings related to his appeal with the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit.
